The Kuemper coaches noticed that Faiza was trying her best to score, and a plan was put into place to give Faiza the opportunity to score. The Kuemper defense did not guard Faiza, instead they stood back to watch as she attempted her shots. Team members, coaches and the entire crowd were cheering her on and after her tenth attempt the ball swished through the net with three seconds left on the clock. It was truly an unselfish act of kindness and compassion shown by Kuemper's coaches and the basketball teams.

Kuemper's coach Snyder said he's been a part of the girls' basketball program for 19 years, but he has "never seen so much joy shown by a player as he saw in Faiza when the teams lined up to shake hands at the end of the game." Snyder added, "Faiza's feet never touched the floor while going through the player's line and that one could see she was on cloud nine as a result of the evening's events."

As for Faiza, a junior at Southeast Valley who is from Bangladesh, says she could not have made the basket without everyone's support. This act of kindness is a moment in time that certainly made an impression for all who were there to witness it.

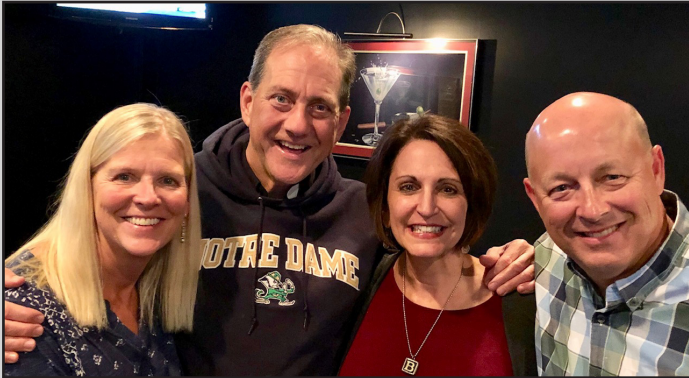

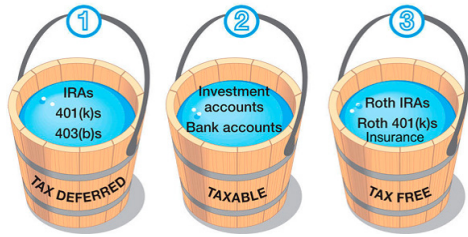

The theme for this year's ball is *Escape the Knight*. Plans are underway to make this evening a fun escape from the everyday chaos of our lives.

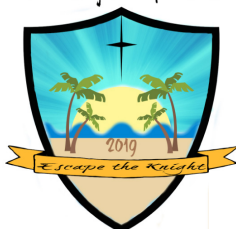
