A WORD FROM OUR CHAPLAIN

Our upcoming Kuemper Ball has taken the theme "A Knight of Hope." And it coincides nicely with the theme of our school year, "Counting Every Blessing." Indeed, much in the last couple of years has seemed to be hopeless. But, I think these difficult times only serve to amplify that the light of Christ shines in and scatters the darkness. Indeed, as St. John says in his Gospel, "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." In the midst of hopelessness, our greatest blessing is the light of Christ and the saving message of the Gospel. I'd like to look at one particular example of where the light of Christ is shining brightly in the Kuemper family.

Kuemper, following the lead of Gehlen Catholic in LeMars, is once again planning this year to send a team of missionaries to Honduras. Honduras is the second most impoverished country in the western hemisphere, trailing only Haiti. But, people there are filled with a sense of hope.

They are grateful for whatever food, water, shelter, and clothing they may have. Scraps of food that we regularly take for granted are cherished in this land as containing within themselves another day of life.

The Kuemper missionaries do not undertake this mission for their sake, or really, even, for the sake of the people of Honduras. At its core, they undertake this mission because of Jesus Christ. It is Jesus who said in Matthew's Gospel, "When you did it to one of these least ones, you did it to me." The missionaries going to serve the wonderful people of Honduras see in each one of them the face of Jesus. It is Jesus who is hungry, thirsty, homeless, tired, and lacking an education. It is Jesus who comes in each missionary to share whatever feeble blessings they have from God with the beloved people of Honduras.

But the irony is that in giving, we also receive. It is not an exaggeration to say that the missionaries going to serve the poor receive far more from the poor than they can ever give. This is what St. John Paul II called, "The law of the gift." Namely, working like clockwork in the mystery of Christian discipleship, if one wishes to receive and be filled, he must first empty his heart of everything that is not God, so that God has room to enter. If we wish to receive blessings, we must give what we have away.

Those in the developing world often have a deep sense of hope that we in the wealthy west can only long for. Simply by having nothing of which to speak materially, they have room in their hearts for the one thing that matters...the indwelling of the Blessed Trinity.

May this new year find each of us filled with hope in God and gratitude for His manifold blessings

KUEMPER TEACHERS AND STUDENTS BRING CREATIVITY, DETERMINATION AND ENTHUSIASM TO THE CLASSROOM EACH AND EVERY DAY!

TEACHING TECHNIQUES

Kuemper High School Science teacher Mrs. Ann Pottebaum (Haberl '93) above, uses a computer simulation in her classroom to provide students with the opportunity to investigate ecosystem models. She has been impressed with her students' ability to make predictions, conduct tests and analyze data to better understand relationship dynamics in the world around them.

Second grade teacher Mrs. Holly (Rutten '04) Janning and her team teach a "Big Bad Wolf" unit, allowing students to make their own house to see if the materials they used could withstand the "wolf" trying to blow them down!

Mrs. Erin Stevens' 7th grade class read *Tell Tale Heart* by Edgar Allen Poe. Based on the evidence provided from the story and their own research of the judicial systems, students were put into one of three teams. One team being the prosecution, one being the defense and one being the jury. The students were to use persuasive techniques to sway the jury to agree with their argument.

POSITIVELY POSITIVE!

This year, Kuemper implemented the PBIS program for grades PK-6. PBIS stands for "Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports." With PBIS, children are taught about behavior expectations and strategies, focusing on rewarding the good, not punishing the bad. Students are awarded tickets, for showing positive behaviors and actions! They can then use these tickets to purchase fun items!

Students can also be nominated by their teachers for "Knight of the Week."

These students show how to be a RED Knight. RED stands for Respect, Effort, Discipleship.

There are posters and flyers hung throughout the buildings outlining and reminding students of these expectations!

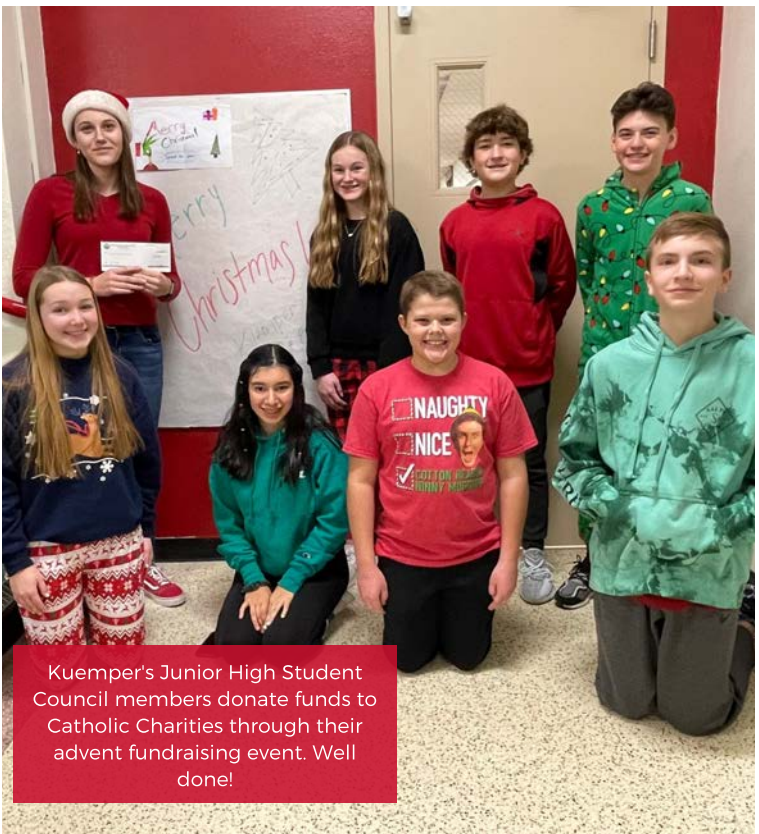


"IT IS MORE BLESSED TO GIVE THAN TO RECEIVE"

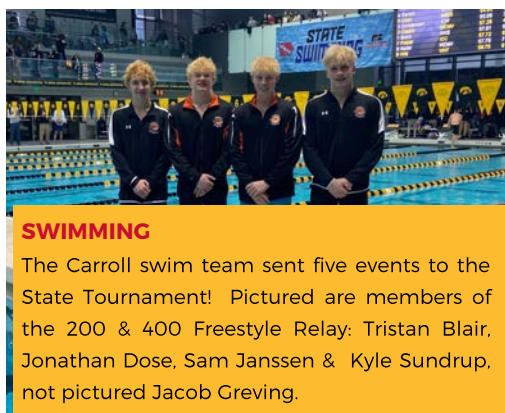
Head coaches Sean Minnehan and Tyler Tryon have been impressed with their player's hard work and great attitudes! At the time of publication both teams have advanced to district play!

JOSEPH SNYDER '95

Commander Joseph Snyder is a native of Breda and the son of Carl and Mary (Gosch) Snyder. He was a parishioner of Saint Bernard and started his Catholic education at Christ the King. He graduated from Kuemper in 1995 and enlisted in the United States Navy that summer. He trained as an Aviation Electronics Technician, with an initial assignment at Air Test and Evaluation Squadron NINE, VX-9, China Lake, California. Snyder was selected for the Broadened Opportunity for Officer Selection and Training Program, Newport, Rhode Island in 1998. He graduated from the University of Saint Thomas, in Saint Paul, Minnesota with a Bachelor of Arts in Financial Management while completing the Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps requirements at the University of Minnesota. Commander Snyder earned his commission in May 2003 and was designated a Naval Aviator in April 2005.

Following initial P-3C Orion training at Naval Air Station Jacksonville, Florida, Snyder began his first operational flying assignment with the Red Lancers of Patrol Squadron TEN, VP-10, in Brunswick, Maine.

Subsequent operational tours include Operations Administration Officer aboard USS Dwight D. Eisenhower (CVN-69) and Department Head with the Pelicans of Patrol Squadron FOUR FIVE, VP-45. Snyder's shore assignments include Flag Lieutenant to Commander, Patrol, and Reconnaissance Group (CPRG), Norfolk, Virginia, VP Sea, Shore, and General Aviation Detailer at the Bureau of Naval Personnel (PERS-43), Millington, Tennessee, and two tours at Patrol Squadron THIRTY, VP-30, as the Safety Officer and Training Department Head.

Commander Snyder is currently a P-8A Poseidon Instructor Pilot and the Commanding Officer of the Grey Knights of Patrol Squadron FOUR SIX, VP-46, Naval Air Station Whidbey Island, Washington. He leads a squadron of 260 Officers and Enlisted personnel operating seven P-8A Poseidon Maritime Patrol Aircraft that conduct operations in defense of our Nation and our national security priorities around the globe.

Skipper Snyder and his wife Rachel were married at Saint Mary's Catholic Church in Sleepy Eye, Minnesota in 2005. They have seven children Noah, Charlotte, Lucy, Elizabeth, Joseph, Jude, and Jet and are parishioners of Saint Mary's Catholic Church in Anacortes, Washington.
