Kuemper Catholic School System Board of Education Minutes April 20, 2021

The April meeting of the Kuemper Catholic School Board was called to order by Chairman, Tom Brincks, on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. in the high school library. The meeting was opened with the school board prayer. Members present included Tom Brincks, Dr. John Evans, Fr. Tim Friedrichsen, Carrie Meyers, Fr. Kevin Richter, Fr. Randy Schon, Mike Sibbel and Gary Wiskus. Absent was Bob Lally.

Also present were President, John Steffes; administrators Ted Garringer and Kathi Milligan; business managers, Kris Collison and Christie Sundrup.

An Opportunity for Input was extended.

Deacon Mark Prosser was present to answer questions about current diocesan pastoral planning. Pastor planning will be ongoing. Prosser reported that the Kuemper resolution sent to the diocese last month asking the Bishop and the diocesan pastoral planning committee to reconsider elements of the pastoral planning changes to Carroll county was declined, and that the scheduled parish changes will still move forward as planned.

Motion to approve the minutes as corrected (change Ministry 2025 pastoral changes to diocesan pastoral planning) of the March 16th meeting was made by Fr. Tim Friedrichsen and seconded by Gary Wiskus. The motion passed.

Administrator and Staff Reports:

Administrative Reports – Written reports were submitted by Ted Garringer, Kathi Milligan and Mike Power.

Marketing & Enrollment Management

In Susie Hulst's written report she stated that the enrollment as of 4-13-21 is 1,130 students, up one since last month. The Discover Kuemper Preschool Night went better than expected. There are currently 89 students on the preschool interest survey for the 2021-2022 school year. Discover Kuemper High School night (freshman orientation) was held April 15th.

Alumni/Annual Giving

Cindy Lawler reported that the Ball is going well and the chaircouples are working very hard. The Ball is May 1.

<u>Development/Fundraising – Foundation</u>

Sharon Olerich's written report stated that as of March 31st, \$49,139.48 of the \$736,166 goal has been collected for the Msgr. Lafferty Tuition Fund. Mary Schon and Denise Higgins are sponsoring new scholarships for 2021-2022. Over 9,000 alumni peer to peer letters will be sent in June for the Teacher Tribute Appeal. The next regular Foundation meeting is April 29th.

Kris Collison reviewed the general fund income and expenses for March 2021, the 2020-2021 Working Fiscal Year Budget.
